Teigen's Instagram account has also given us a glimpse into the glamorous New York City apartment the couple keeps. That said, you can imagine our surprise when news broke last week that the pair had decided to sell their Manhattan digs.



Reportedly, the stars are looking for a more spacious home in the city, with room to start a family. While there's is one celeb baby we'd love to see, we'll definitely miss getting to peek inside their current apartment.



But, if there's one thing we can count on, it's that Teigen and Legend are moving on to bigger and better. So, we took it upon ourselves to find a couple of swoon-worthy Manhattan listings that would be perfect for the couple and their growing family. The credentials: a spacious kitchen for chef-extraordinaire Teigen, room to entertain celebrity friends like Kim Kardashian and Kanye West, and, of course, plenty of space for a nursery and kids rooms.

Here are four top contenders:

#### 1) 111 East 56th Street

Our friends at Citi Habitats combed their listings to find this gem: an elegant and sprawling penthouse on the entire top floor of the Upper East Side's Lombardy hotel. Priced at \$4.295 million, the 3,800-square-foot property has three bedrooms, two bathrooms, a powder room, an large chef's kitchen, and an expansive terrace perfect for entertaining guests or playing with the (future) kids.





As celebrities, it's important their next home offers privacy and security. For its part, the East 56th street penthouse has a private elevator that opens directly into the unit. And it wouldn't be the home's first brush with fame. The hotel building was built in the 1920s by publishing icon William Randolph Hearst, and the apartment itself has been lived in by author Edna Ferber, composer Richard Rodgers, and Broadway producer Albert Tapper.

## 2) 1 Centre Market Place

Next up, from <u>CORE</u>, a four-story townhouse on the borderline of lower Manhattan neighborhoods SoHo and Nolita. Built on a low-traffic block, the <u>five bedroom home</u> offers 4,100 square feet of living space, two terraces, and a roof deck.






#### 3) 50 West Street

Located in Manhattan's Financial District, penthouse 59B of the <u>luxury high-rise</u> offers sweeping views and access to a rapidly developing, family-friendly area. The 3,594-square-foot unit boasts three bedrooms, four bathrooms, an open kitchen, and ample living space for party hosting.

# 4) 51 Jay Street
